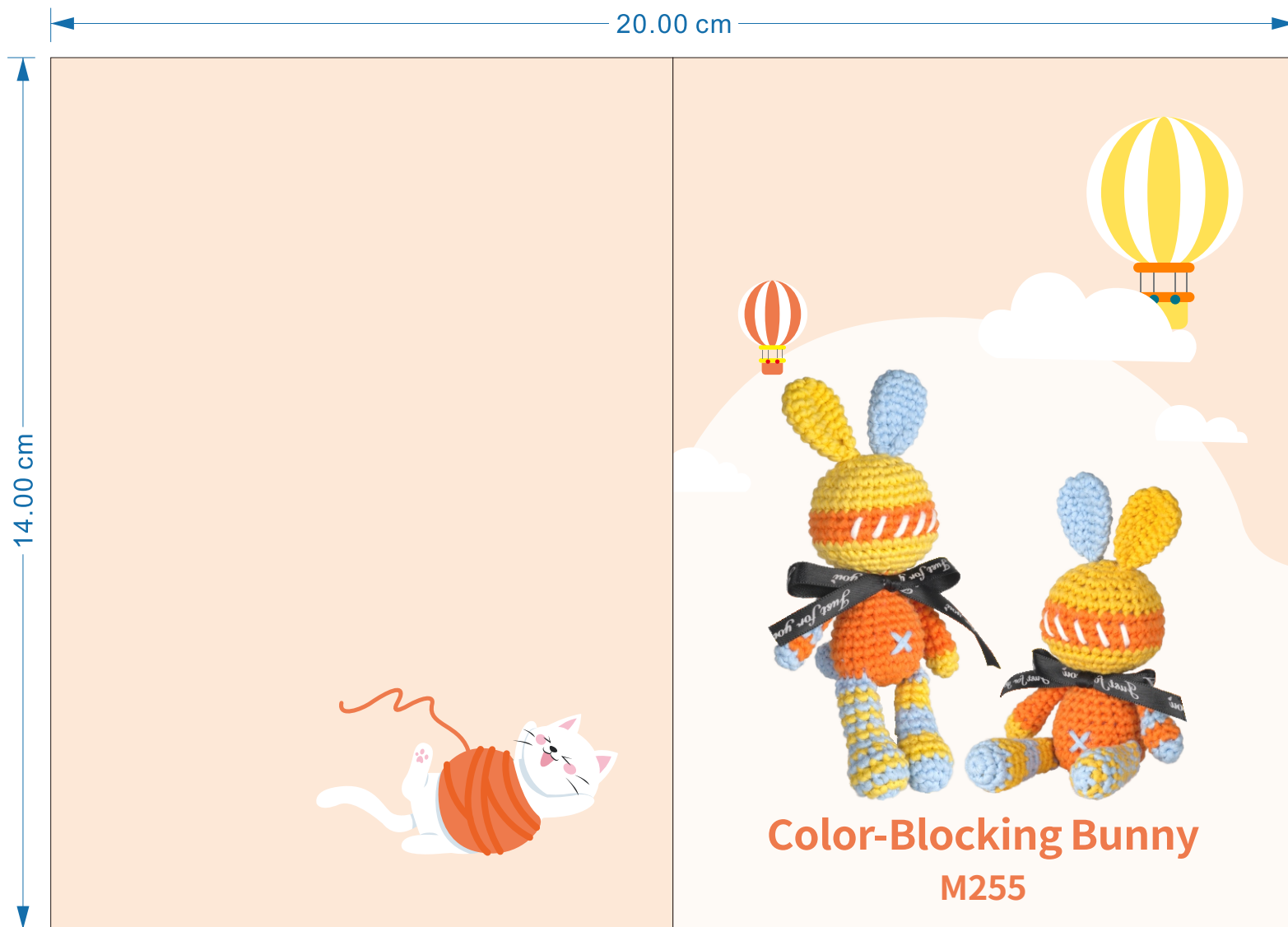

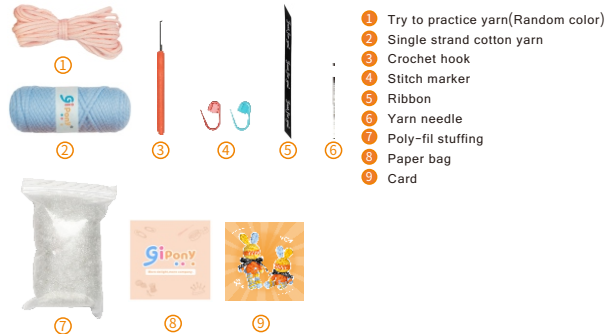

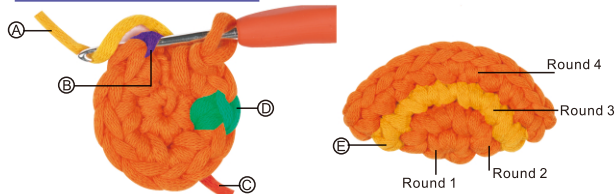

Terminology



- ④ Working yarn Yarn connected to the ball of yarn.
- ⑤ Top loops of a stitch Where you usually insert the hook, to start the next stitch.
- ⑥ Yarn tail (end) End of yarn not connected to the ball of yarn.
- ⑦ Single crochet stitch The main stitch used in amigurumi.
- ⑧ Round A series of crochet stitches in a circle.
This illustrated crochet piece is made of 4 rounds.

Abbreviations

This pattern is written in US terminology

ch	chain stitch	tr	treble crochet
sc	single crochet	ss	slip stitch
inc	increase	st	stitch
dec	decrease	BLO	through back loops only
hdc	half double crochet	FLO	through front loops only

How to read the pattern ?

round
RND4

total number of stitches in the round
(2sc, inc)*6
24sts

What stitches to do in this round, and how many times

For round 4, repeat the pattern in the brackets for 6 times. The pattern is: single crochet in each of the first 2 stitches, then increase stitch in the next stitch. Because an increase is actually 2 single crochet stitches in the same stitch, the total number of stitches in this round is 24.

The terms "1ch and ss" are considered a "joined round" in crochet terminology.
A "joined round" is not counted as a stitch in crochet.

Materials

Single strand cotton yarn, 2.5mm hook, Stitch marker,
Fiberfill, Yarn needle, Ribbon.

Abbreviations

ch=chain stitch

ss=slip stitch

inc=increase

(,,)*n=work all instructions in the brackets as many
times as directed.

[,,]=work all instructions in the square brackets in the
same stitch.

sc=single crochet

st(s)=stitch(es)

dec=decrease



Top Tips:

Start with a magic ring, working in rounds which are joined together at the end of each round.

Start with A Magic Ring:

Wrap the yarn around your little finger and then bring the yarn up to your index finger. Pinch the yarn tail with thumb and middle finger. Make a loop around your middle finger and pinch the crossover of the yarn. Insert hook into the loop, yarn over/under the hook and pull up a loop. The loop on your middle finger will become a magic ring.

1 Head(Make 1)

(Start with yellow yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring: 1ch, 6sc, ss = 6sts

Place a locking stitch marker in first st. Moving the stitch marker up with each rnd, cont as folls.

Rnd2: 1ch, 6inc, ss = 12sts

Rnd3: 1ch, (sc, inc)*6 times, ss = 18sts

Rnd4: 1ch, (inc, 2sc)*6 times, ss = 24sts



Rnd5: 1ch, (3sc, inc)*6 times, ss = 30sts

Rnds6-7: 1ch, 30sc, ss = 30sts

Rnd8: **Change to orange yarn:** 1ch, 30sc, ss = 30sts

Rnd9: 1ch, 7sc, 3inc, 10sc, 3inc, 7sc, ss = 36sts

Rnd10: 1ch, 36sc, ss = 36sts

Rnd11: **Change to yellow yarn:** 1ch, 36sc, ss = 36sts

Rnd12: 1ch, 7sc, 3dec, 10sc, 3dec, 7sc, ss = 30sts

Rnd13: 1ch, (3sc, dec)*6 times, ss = 24sts

Rnd14: 1ch, (dec, 2sc)*6 times, ss = 18sts

Rnd15: 1ch, (sc, dec)*6 times, ss = 12sts

Stuff the fabric with fiberfill.

Rnd16: 1ch, 6dec, ss = 6sts

Break yarn, sew hole closed and weave in end.

2 Body(Make 1)

(Start with orange yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring:

1ch, 6sc, ss = 6sts

Rnd2: 1ch, 6inc, ss = 12sts

Rnd3: 1ch, (sc, inc)*6 times, ss = 18sts



Rnd4: 1ch,(inc,2sc)*6 times,ss = 24sts

Rnds5-7: 1ch,24sc,ss = 24sts

Rnd8: 1ch,(3sc,dec,3sc)*3 times,ss = 21sts

Rnd9: 1ch,21sc,ss = 21sts

Rnd10: 1ch,(5sc,dec)*3 times,ss = 18sts

Rnd11: 1ch,18sc,ss = 18sts

Rnd12: 1ch,(2sc,dec,2sc)*3 times,ss = 15sts

Rnd13: 1ch,15sc,ss = 15sts

Fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.

3 Ear(Make 2; One for Each Color)

(Start with yellow or blue yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring:1ch,6sc,ss = 6sts

Rnd2: 1ch,6inc,ss = 12sts

Rnds3-5: 1ch,12sc,ss = 12sts

Rnd6: 1ch,sc,dec,9sc,ss = 11sts

Rnd7: 1ch,sc,dec,8sc,ss = 10sts

Rnd8: 1ch,sc,dec,7sc,ss = 9sts

Rnd9: 1ch,2sc,dec,3sc,dec,ss = 7sts

Fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.



4 Left Arm(Make 1)

(Start with blue yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring:

1ch,4sc,ss = 4sts

Rnd2: 1ch,(sc,inc)*2 times,ss = 6sts

Rnd3: **Change to orange yarn:**

1ch,(inc,2sc)*2 times,ss = 8sts

Rnd4: 1ch,8sc,ss = 8sts

Rnd5: **Change to blue yarn:**1ch,8sc,ss = 8sts

Rnd6: 1ch,(2sc,dec)*2 times,ss = 6sts

Rnds7-8: **Change to orange yarn:**1ch,6sc,ss = 6sts

Rnds9-10: **Change to blue yarn:**1ch,6sc,ss = 6sts

Rnd11: **Change to orange yarn:**1ch,6sc,ss = 6sts

Fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.



5 Right Arm(Make 1)

(Start with yellow yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring:

1ch,4sc,ss = 4sts

Rnd2: 1ch,(sc,inc)*2 times,ss = 6sts



Rnd3: 1ch,(inc,2sc)*2 times,ss = 8sts

Rnds4-5: **Change to orange yarn:** 1ch,8sc,ss = 8sts

Rnd6: 1ch,(2sc,dec)*2 times,ss = 6sts

Rnds7-11: 1ch,6sc,ss = 6sts

Fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.

6 Left Leg(Make 1)

(Start with blue yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring:

1ch,6sc,ss = 6sts

Rnd2: **Change to yellow yarn:**

1ch,(sc,inc)*3 times,ss = 9sts

Rnd3: **Change to blue yarn:**

1ch,(inc,2sc)*3 times,ss = 12sts

Rnd4: **Change to yellow yarn:** 1ch,12sc,ss = 12sts

Rnd5: **Change to blue yarn:** 1ch,12sc,ss = 12sts

Rnd6: **Change to yellow yarn:** 1ch,3sc,3dec,3sc,ss = 9sts

Rnd7: **Change to blue yarn:** 1ch,9sc,ss = 9sts

Rnd8: **Change to yellow yarn:** 1ch,9sc,ss = 9sts

Stuff the fabric with fiberfill.



Rnd9: **Change to blue yarn:** 1ch,3sc,dec,4sc,ss = 8sts

Rnds10-13: Follow the order of one round of yellow and one round of blue: 1ch,8sc,ss = 8sts

Fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.

7 Right Leg(Make 1)

(Start with blue yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring:

1ch,6sc,ss = 6sts

Rnd2: 1ch,(sc,inc)*3 times,ss = 9sts

Rnd3: 1ch,(inc,2sc)*3 times,ss = 12sts

Rnds4-5: **Change to yellow yarn:** 1ch,12sc,ss = 12sts

Rnd6: 1ch,3sc,3dec,3sc,ss = 9sts

Rnds7-8: **Change to blue yarn:** 1ch,9sc,ss = 9sts

Stuff the fabric with fiberfill.

Rnd9: 1ch,3sc,dec,4sc,ss = 8sts

Rnds10-12: **Change to yellow yarn:** 1ch,8sc,ss = 8sts

Rnd13: **Change to blue yarn:** 1ch,8sc,ss = 8sts

Fasten off and weave in end.



8 Tail(Make 1)

(Start with blue yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring:

1ch,6sc,ss = 6sts

Rnd2: 1ch,(2sc,inc)*2 times,ss = 8sts

Rnds3-4: 1ch,8sc,ss = 8sts

Stuff the fabric with fiberfill.

Rnd5: 1ch,4dec,ss = 4sts

Fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.

Then sew hole closed.



9 Sew Up

Note: You can choose to make standing or sitting bunny according to your own preferences, but there are differences in the stitching of the legs. Please refer to the video or pictures for details.

①For the body and the head,the side with ss is the back.

Then sew the body under the head, on Rnd 15 of the head.

②Sew up the opening of each ear first. Then fold the ear and sew some stitches at the bottom to shape it. Finally, sew the ears to either side of the head, on Rnd 2, with the blue ear on the right, and the yellow ear on the left, bilateral symmetry.



③Sew up the opening of each arm first; then sew the arms to either side of the body, on Rnd 13, bilateral symmetry.

④Sew up the opening of each leg first; then sew the legs to either side of the body, on Rnds 4-5, bilateral symmetry. Next, sew some stitches in front of the leg to make it fit the body.

⑤ Sew the tail to the back of the body, between Rnds 5-6.

⑥ Take a piece of white yarn and embroider 5 stripes on Rnds 9-10 of the head, spacing every two strips 2 stitches apart.

⑦ Take a piece of blue yarn, and embroider an "X" shaped belly button on Rnds 6-7 of the body, counting from the bottom.

⑧ Standing bunny's legs: Flatten the top of each leg and sew the legs to either side of the body, on Rnd 4 (counting from the bottom), bilateral symmetry.

⑨ Tie a bow knot around the bunny's neck with a black ribbon.
